Amy Elgersma, Chief Administrative Officer, on behalf of Alison Drummond, Senior Director of Corporate Services, presented a Request for Decision to report expenses incurred from October 12 to October 31, 2021 and request a resolution for a funding

application to the Government of Nunavut under the Municipal Request for Assistance Program regarding the water quality emergency.

Ms. Elgersma explained that based on Purchasing By-law #820, she is required to submit a report to Council describing expenditures made under special circumstances during the emergency. She noted that instead of waiting until the end of the emergency, a monthly committed expenses report will be provided to Council.
