

The Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit, Nunavut

By-law No. 825

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of Iqaluit to amend Ambulance Services By-law No. 670;

WHEREAS the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.Nu 2003, c.2., Section 101 provides for the passage of by-laws regarding the establishment and operation of an ambulance service and regarding the entering of agreements with the Government of Nunavut respecting ambulance services;

WHEREAS the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.Nu 2003, c.2., Sections 109, 110, 182 and 183 and any amendments thereto provides for the regulation of businesses through classification and licensing and regarding the punishment for by-law offences;

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Cities, Towns, and Villages Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c.8, section 65, a Council may, by by-law, amend or repeal a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to the provisions of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act* and amendments thereto, the Council of the City of Iqaluit in regular session duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 3.5 is amended by removing (EMR).**
- 2. The following definitions shall be added:**
 - 3.11-“Medical Director” shall mean a physician who provides guidance, leadership, oversight and quality assurance for the practice of local EMS with the City of Iqaluit boundaries.”**
 - 3.12-“Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) or Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) shall mean a person who is specially trained and certified to administer basic emergency services to victims of trauma or acute illness before and during transportation to a hospital or other healthcare facility.”**
 - 3.13-“Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) shall mean people who are specially trained to provide out-of-hospital care in medical emergencies.”**
 - 3.14-“Basic Trauma Life Support (BTLS) shall mean a level of medical care which is used for victims of life-threatening illnesses or injuries until they can be given full medical care at a hospital.”**
- 3. Schedule “A” of By-law No. 670 is replaced with Schedule “A” of this by-law.**

SECTION 7 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law shall come into force and effect on January 1, 2017.

Department Personnel Chief	\$125.00 per hour
