BY-LAW NO. 354

EMERGENCY MEASURES BY-LAW

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF IQALUIT IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO ESTABLISH A PLAN FOR THE CO-ORDINATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES IN THE EVENT OF PEACE TIME EMERGENCIES OR THE THREAT OF ANY SUCH EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO THE CIVIL EMERGENCY MEASURES ACT R.S.N.W.T. 1988 c.C-9, S.7, 14, 17 (1) CITY, TOWN AND VILLAGE ACT R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c C-8, S. 27.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of Iqaluit in a meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

1) **SHORT TITLE:**

This By-law may be cited as the "Emergency Measures By-law".

2) <u>DEFINITIONS:</u>

Are set out in Schedule "A" as attached to this By-law and referred to as the "Plan for Co-ordination of Municipality Emergency Services for the Municipality of Iqaluit".

3) <u>DECLARATION OF A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY</u>


- a) In event of an emergency or threat of emergency, council may by resolution declare a State of Local Emergency to exist.
- b) In the absence of Council the Plan attached as Schedule "A" sets out the alternative procedures for declaring a State of Local Emergency.
- 4) PLAN FOR THE CO-ORDINATION OF TOWN EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF IQALUIT.

The Council approves the attached Plan forming Schedule "A" of this By-law as the primary document to govern how the Local Authority will respond to emergency situations or perceived emergencies in the Municipality of Iqaluit.

5) REVISION

The attached Plan forming Schedule "A" to the By-law be revised and updated as may be necessary from time to time upon the approval of the Emergency Response Co-ordinator and that all such revisions be distributed to all recipients of the Plan.
