BY-LAW 503

SIGNING AUTHORITY BY-LAW

A By-law of the Municipality of Iqaluit in Nunavut to appoint officer(s), other than the Senior Administrative Officer, and to establish the powers and duties of the officer(s) pursuant to section 44 of Cities, Towns and Villages Act of Nunavut, the R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8;

WHEREAS the Cities, Towns and Villages Act provides that the municipal council may, by by-law, appoint employees to be officers and authorize them to perform any statutory duty assigned to the Senior Administrative Officer other than those assigned under section 47; or, any other duties the council considers necessary;

NOWHEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Iqaluit, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. In this by-law:

| (f) “schedule” | means a schedule attached to and forms part of this by-law |

APPOINTMENT

2. (a) The person holding the position named in Part 1 of Schedule “A” is hereby appointed as an officer and in the absence of the Senior Administrative Officer has authority to sign negotiable instruments on behalf of the Town as referenced in section 141 of the Act.

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(b) The person(s) holding the position(s) named in Part 2 of Schedule “A” are hereby appointed as officers for the purpose of authorizing disbursements in accordance subsection 48.(1)(h) of the Act and as specified in Schedule “A”.

ENACTMENT

This by-law shall come into force upon third and final reading.
