

## **THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF IQALUIT, NUNAVUT**

### **BY-LAW # 615**

#### **PLATEAU SUBDIVISION WATER BOOSTER STATION**

**BEING** a By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit in Nunavut Territory authorizing the City to enter into a Contract for the construction of the Plateau Subdivision Water Booster Station;

**WHEREAS** the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c.8, Section 53.3 as amended by S.Nu. 2003, c.2 specifies that Council can enter into contracts on behalf of the Municipal Corporation;

**NOW THEREFORE** the City Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit, in a Regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

#### **SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this by-law is declared invalid because of any word, phase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this by-law or any documents which form part of this by-law or an application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in force.

#### **SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE**

This By-Law may be cited as the “Plateau Subdivision Water Booster Station By-Law”.

#### **SECTION 2 – CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THAT the City enters into Construction Contract with Kudlik Construction Ltd. as per their Tender dated July 21, 2005 in the amount of \$2,744,550 including taxes and GST.

#### **SECTION 3 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

This By-law shall come into effect on the Third and Final Reading.
