14-56	Stevenson	Akumalik	That Council approve the issue of one or more debentures totalling \$26,500,000.00 to Canada Life Assurance Co. or its affiliates, the proceeds of which are to be used only for the planning, construction and outfitting of the proposed Aquatic Centre. The debentures shall pay interest at a fixed rate of 2.4% above the mid-market interpolated average life Government of Canada Bonds, to be set within 5 days of the anticipated issue of the fund. As of March 10, 2014, the relevant Government of Canada Bonds rate was approximately 3.0% so the debenture interest rate would have been approximately 5.4%. The term of the debenture shall be 22 years, repayable by monthly payments of interest only for the first 2 years, then by blended monthly principle and interest payments sufficient to repay the debentures in the remaining 20 years. The form of the debentures and other related legal documents shall be satisfactory to the Chief Administrative Officer and the City's legal counsel. The Chief Administrative Officer and the Mayor are authorized to sign the debentures and other related documents required to issue the debentures.	7			unanimous
