Water Shut Down in Happy Valley on September 8

September 4, 2020 – Iqaluit, Nunavut

Please be advised that a water interruption will be taking place in Happy Valley on **Tuesday, September 8th, 2020** from approximately 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. to allow for scheduled repairs to our water infrastructure.
