Emergency Water Shut Down and Boil Water Advisory in Happy Valley

March 15, 2021 - Igaluit, Nunavut

Please be advised of an emergency water shut down in Happy Valley on **Tuesday, March 15**, **2021 from approximately <u>2:30 p.m.</u>** to <u>3:30 p.m.</u> to allow for a repair to the water infrastructure.

Residents in the following locations may be affected: 400s, 1600s, and 500s.

The City of Iqaluit is issuing a boil water advisory for these residents who experience water loss.

This is a precautionary measure due to a break in the water line during a repair to our water infrastructure.

The City recommends that all water used for consumption and dental hygiene is brought to a rolling boil for a minimum of one full minute. Water can boiled in a pot over the stove, allowed to cool and stored in a covered container or refrigerated for later use.

The City of Iqaluit will release a Public Service Announcement when the boil water advisory is lifted.
