Update on City of Iqaluit ICFI Food/Diaper Program

March 12, 2025 – Iqaluit, Nunavut

The City of Iqaluit is pleased to hear that the Government of Canada has renewed the Inuit Child First Initiative (ICFI). This important program provides essential support for Inuit children and families, and we recognize its significant impact on our community.

At this time, the City has not yet received confirmation regarding any changes required for our participation in the program. Under our current agreement with Indigenous Services Canada, our food and diaper voucher program remains set to conclude on March 31, 2025. We are awaiting further details on how the renewed funding may affect our program, including potential changes to the application process.

We appreciate the value this initiative brings to Iqaluit families and will provide updates as soon as more information becomes available. Thank you for your patience and understanding—we look forward to learning how the renewed funding may continue to support our community.
