c) Request for Decision – Development Permit Aquatic Centre Project Melodie Simard, Planning and Development

Administration noted that the parking related issues were discussed during the In Camera session. Some of the most important conditions attached to the development permit application 13-067 for Lot 534, Plan 911 are as follows:

Snow Clearing / Storage

3. The Developer/Lessee shall remove piled snow from the site when there is no longer space to pile snow or where snow piling is causing excessive snow-drifting. Upon completion of construction and prior to occupancy, snow storage shall be provided on Lot 6, Block 71, Plan 3799 (i.e. the Frosty Lot). In the interim, snow shall be stored on the northeasterly portion of Lot 534, Plan 911. The snow storage shall not be located on the parking area currently dedicated to Lot 3, Block 72, Plan 3782.

Cross-Walks

5. The City will assess the feasibility of adding a crosswalk on Kangiq and Iniq Drive linking the Aquatic Centre site to the off-site parking area, and adding a crosswalk on Niaqungunsiariaq Road <u>prior to the</u> <u>issuance of the Occupancy Permit.</u>

Amendments to Development Permits

6. An Amendment to the Development Permits of Lot 1, Block 72, Plan 3502 and Lot 3, Block 72, Plan 3782 shall be required <u>prior to the issuance of the Occupancy Permit</u>. The amended Development Permit for Lot 1, Block 72, Plan 3502 shall show the walkway linking Lot 534, Plan 911 to Lot 6, Block 71, Plan 3799.

The amended Development Permit for Lot 3, Block 72, Plan 3782 shall

recognize the relocation of the 8 parking spaces from Lot 534, Plan 911 to Lot 6, Block 71, Plan 3799.

Off-Site Parking

7. Off-site parking shall be provided on Lot 6, Block 71, Plan 3799 prior to the issuance of the Occupancy Permit.

Administration stated that after further discussion with the Recreation Department, it was suggested that the two last sections of Condition 3. Snow Clearing/Storage "In the interim, snow shall be stored on the northeasterly portion of Lot 534, Plan 911. The snow storage shall not be located on the parking area currently dedicated to Lot 3, Block 72, Plan 3782." be removed.
