REMINDER: DISABLED PARKING SPOTS ARE RESERVED FOR CITIZENS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

DECEMBER 8, 2016 (Iqaluit, Nunavut) - The City of Iqaluit would like to remind residents to please not park in areas reserved for disabled parking. These parking spots are provided to assist individuals with special needs, who also have and display a valid "handicapped identification permit", which allows them to park in these designated areas.

To obtain a valid "handicapped identification permit", residents should contact the Government of Nunavut Department of Transportation.

Please also note that as per Bylaw 625, the fine for parking in a disabled parking spot without a proper permit is \$50, and may also include the possibility of having the vehicle towed. The court may also award additional penalties including fines up to \$2,000 for an individual, and \$10,000 for a corporation.
