

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF IQALUIT

BY-LAW No. 799

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC BY-LAW AMENDMENT

BEING a By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit in Nunavut to amend Highway Traffic By-law No. 319.

WHEREAS the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, permits the City to regulate the use of vehicles and public safety;

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the authority granted by the Act, the Council of the City of Iqaluit, in regular session duly assembled, enact as follows:

1) That the interpretation section be amended by adding the following;

"Abandoned vehicle" means a motor vehicle that is located on a highway and which;

- (i) Does not appear to be in operating condition; or
- (ii) Does not have attached to it a current plate issued under the "*Motor Vehicle Act*" of Nunavut; or
- (iii) Is wrecked, dismantled, partially dismantled, stripped or partially stripped;

And which remains on a highway 72 hours after a notice described in subsection 8(2) has been attached to it.

"*Fire lane*" means an access route for fire department vehicles required by the National Building Code of Canada for firefighting purposes and marked by signage as a fire lane;

2) That Section 16 of the By-Law be amended by adding the following subsections:

8(1) or allow the vehicle to be abandoned.

8(2) The notice referred to in the definition of "**Abandoned vehicle**" must include:

- (a) A description of the vehicle to which it is being attached, including the number on any plate attached to the vehicle;
- (b) The date and time it is attached to the vehicle;
- (c) A statement that, if it is not removed within 72 hours of the date and time the notice was attached to the vehicle, the vehicle will meet the definition of "abandoned vehicle" and will be taken to and stored in a suitable place;
- (d) An officer's number or other identification of the person issuing the notice.

9 on any portion of a highway marked by signage as a fire lane.

(3) That Schedule B, be amended to include the following:

Offence	Section	Voluntary Payment
Abandon vehicle on highway	16(8)(1)	\$100.00
Parked or Stopped in a Marked Fire Lane	16(9)	\$150.00
Towing Fee	20(2)	\$ 180.00
Storage and Impound –per day	20(2)	\$ 20.00
Administrative Fee	20(2)	\$ 15.00

This By-law shall come into effect on Third and Final Reading.


