BY-LAW #601

PROPERTY DISPOSAL BY-LAW

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit, in Nunavut to provide for the disposal of real property pursuant to the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.Nu. 2003;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Iqaluit has the authority to pass by-laws regarding personal property pursuant to Section 53.7 (4) (c) of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.Nu 2003;

AND WHEREAS no real property may be acquired by, held or disposed of by the Municipal Corporation except in accordance Property Procedures By-law #404;

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to the provisions of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.Nu. 2003 the Council of the City of Iqaluit, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this by-law is declared invalid because of any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this by-law or any documents which form part of this by-law or an application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in force.

SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE


This By-Law may be cited as the "Property Disposal By-Law".
