Mayor Wilman called the Public Hearing to order at 6:00 p.m., acknowledged the gallery and noted that Administration would continue with the public hearing on Zoning By-law Amendment No. 786.

Administration explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing is to permit a retail store and studio custom clothing business on Lot 46, Plan 674. This lot is located in the Core Area, generally between the Tittaq building and Parish Hall. The lot is currently zoned Residential. A by-law amendment is required in order to permit the retail store and studio custom clothing store to be located on this lot. Schedule B and Schedule B Map 2 of the current by-law would be amended to change the lot from Residential Medium Density to Central Business Zone Special Exception 2. A second amendment would permit a change to the interior yard setback from six metres to three metres.
